Cub Scout Leader Specific Training

8:00 AM – 9:30 AM Introduction to Cub Scouting

If you have attended the *Introduction to Cub Scouting* (have attended basic Cub Scout Leader training before) you only need to attend the split session for your current role.

9:30 – 11:30 Leader Specific split sessions.

This training is composed of two parts. The Introduction to Cub Scouting gives an overview of the Cub Scout program and how a pack operates. The second part is the leader specific breakout sessions for:

Den Chief Training 8:00 AM – 12:00

This is a training course for Boy Scouts who are or who want to be Den Chiefs. The course covers the role and responsibilities of a Den Chief, the structure of a den meeting, and den activities.

Commissioner Basic Training 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM

Commissioner Basic Training is a Saturday course offered to all new Commissioners and those who wish to “brush up on their skills.” This course will include the role of the commissioner, unit visitations, membership management, the charter renewal process, commissioner awards and honors, and much more!

BSA Troop Committee Challenge Training 8:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Troop Committee Training is for troop committee members, although parents and other troop leaders are invited to attend. Learn about the responsibilities of a troop committee, how the committee should be organized, and the positions to be filled on the committee.

BSA Scoutmaster / Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training 8:00 AM - 2:30 PM

This is the initial training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters (and other interested persons). This course covers the essentials of their leadership positions and provides information to help them become successful Scout leaders. Learn about working with the boys, troop organization, the patrol method, the outdoor program, the advancement program, and program planning. To be fully trained, Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters must also attend the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training (OLS). The next OLS course will be held 14-16 MAY 2010 at Camp Westmoreland.

Varsity Coach Specific Training 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM

Learn about being a Varsity Coach, Assistant Coach, or Team Committee Member.

Merit Badge Counselor Training 11:00 AM – 12:00 PM

Learn all about being a merit badge counselor, from getting registered to how the merit badge process works. No charge if you only take this course. This course is a one-time requirement for all Merit Badge Counselors.

This is Scouting 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM

This is Scouting introduces the mission, vision, and values of the Scouting program and gives a general overview of the program. It covers Scouting in the community and how the Scouting program protects our youth. This course and **Youth Protection** can also be taken online at <http://olc.scouting.org/>. If you have taken this course once, you do not need to take it again. **This Is Scouting** replaces the New Leaders Essentials.
