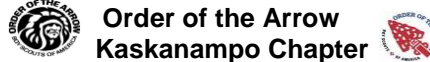

Youth safety is the No. 1 concern of the BSA.

--Youth Protection training is required for all registered volunteers and must be taken every two years. If a volunteer's Youth Protection training record is not current at the time of recharter, the volunteer will not be reregistered.

--New leaders are required to take Youth Protection before they submit application for registration. The certificate of completion for this training must be with application and before volunteer service with youth begins.

--Youth Protection training is available online at MyScouting. You don't have to be a registered volunteer or have an ID number to take Youth Protection training. Just log in to MyScouting and create an account. From the MyScouting portal, click on E-Learning and take the Youth Protection training. Upon completion, **print a certificate** and submit it with an application or submit to the unit leader for processing at the local council. If you have an ID number use it, if you don't know your number contact your unit leader. If you have taken Youth Protection training within the past two years but did not take the course online, log on to MyScouting to ensure your records are up-to-date.
